ADMINISTRATIVE DETAILS

OLD BUSINESS

<u>UPDATE ON RWIP GRANT:</u> RWIP grant is moving forward, 12 individual projects – 7 are childcare related, 2 are related to the CTEs, and the rest was workforce attraction. For the Grafton Daycare project, Grafton Economic Development has committed a \$30,000 match, only need an additional \$27,000 for the total match. An offer was put on the place but it is contingent on purchasing the empty lot next door which is in progress. Commerce did submit a request to extend the deadline of the grant until possibly June of 2024, if not the end of this year.

<u>NEW BOARD MEMBER RECOMMENDATION:</u> Julie Byron was recommended by Matt Beneda to replace him as the representative from the banking community. Moen motioned to approve, seconded by Kelley. Motion Carried. Mary Houdek works for Job Service ND and has previously been on the JDA board but due to organizational restructuring at Job

Service stepped down from the board. Motioned by Halverson to have Houdek on the board as a representative from the local job service. Seconded by Gemmill. Motion carried.
